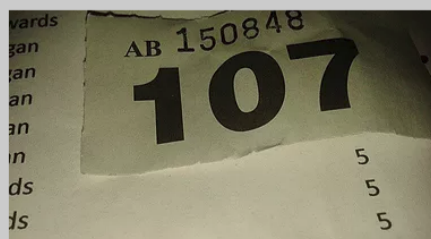

IMPORTANT NOTE: This is an INTERNATIONAL RAFFLE – donations outside of the UK are welcome. The Just Giving process can work two ways for International participants:

- Make your donation in GBP and allow your bank to do the conversion. Your bank may charge a fee for doing this. (It's the same as making a purchase in the UK with your local credit card.)

or . . .

- Use the drop-down menu beside donation amount to use the currency of your country. The number of raffle tickets will correspond to the conversion into GBP (for example, if Lin in the US donates \$10 USD, she would actually only receive one ticket since that is only just over £7.)

Postage fees for mailing the prize to ANYONE, regardless of what country they live in, will be covered by Team LMAS. We want you to spend your funds on raffle tickets, not postage. :)



So, go ahead, splurge on raffle tickets for Lee's *own Beanie* (which has been on his *own head!!!*) . .
